The NMLB will consider a proposed amendment to 21.32.10 NMAC, Livestock Board Fees. The purpose of the proposed rule amendment to 21.32.10.14 DEPOSITS, is to provide NMLB inspectors the statutory maximum of ten (10) days to deposit fee monies collected, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 77-2-10. The proposed rule also allows for the Executive Director to propose designated banks with confirmation from the Board and to direct the use of alternative financial institutions in emergency situations.
